Thursday May 5th – is Election Day – sorry NO Activity Group sessions on this day.

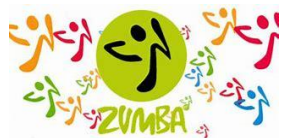

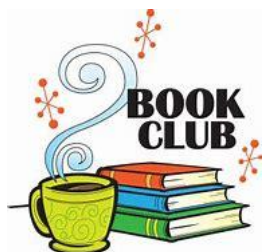
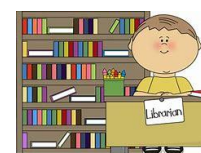
