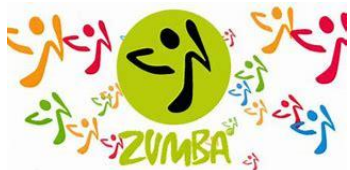
Hopefully there will be no changes to this programme but please do keep a check on the A frame and remember to BOOK IN ADVANCE.

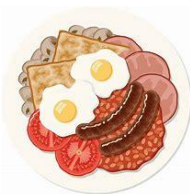
Quiz Night
